Civility and Communication Course

Three days

Addresses disruptive behaviors and communication problems in the workplace, either with staff, administration, or patients.



Medical Record Keeping Course

Two days

Addresses deficiencies in medical record keeping

NEW! Record Review Program



Proper Prescribing Course

Two days

Addresses deficiencies in prescribing practices, especially regarding controlled substances, pain management, and addiction



Risk Management Course

One day

Broad-based overview of potential risks nurses face





Personalized Protection Plan

- A "living" practical action plan with timeframes and reminders built in
 - Organizational Changes to the work setting or to their engagement with the work setting
 - Professional Ways they will demonstrate staying in their professional role
 - Personal Ways of improving physical, mental health, relationships; self-care





Extended Edition (MAS)

- Faculty-led group teleconference seminars
- One hour weekly, for total of 12 seminars
- Cohort based; same faculty and participants each week
- Can be added to any live PBI course
